## **RULES & REGULATIONS**

1. All entry forms must be properly completed and forwarded together with the entry fees *and stall fees (plus GST) to:*

### **Entries to be in the office by Monday, July 19, 2010**

2. No stock will be allowed to compete as Purebred unless Certificates of Registration are produced and handed to the secretary at the time of entry.
3. Livestock must be bonafide property of the exhibitor at the time of the show and at least 30 days preceding, where specified in the prize list.
4. The number of entries allowed per exhibitor shall be specified per section.
5. In the absence of competition in any section or if the stock exhibited be of inferior quality, the judges are to award only such premiums as they think the animals deserving of. They will exercise their discretion as to whether they will award first, second, third, or any other prize.
6. On arrival, each exhibitor will be provided with an exhibitor number – specifying the classes entered. This card must be retained and exhibited by the exhibitor during the exhibition.
7. No person shall be allowed to interfere with the judge while in the discharge of their duties. Exhibitors interfering will forfeit their right or any premium to which they might otherwise be entitled; also the immediate expulsion from the show and grounds.
8. All livestock entries to leave no sooner than 6:00 P.M. on Sunday, July 25th.
9. All livestock owners/exhibitors must be prepared to have their entry ready for judging when called.
10. The directors will take every precaution to ensure the safety of the animals at the exhibition, and should an animal be accidentally injured, lost, or stolen, they will give all the assistance in their power towards recovery of same, but they will not make any payment to the value thereof.
11. The fair board will not be responsible for goods left after the final day.
12. Any infringement of Rules & Regulations will be punished by withholding prizes, expulsion from the Society or both.
13. Prize monies will be paid the week after Stampede. A summary sheet will accompany your cheque. Please review it carefully! Should there be any discrepancies, please phone the office at

204-746-2552 to report the oversight. **NO ADJUSTMENTS WILL BE MADE AFTER SEPTEMBER 15, 2010, as the financial year end for the VAS is September 30, 2010.**

14. Parking is very limited on the grounds. All vehicles must have a vehicle pass displayed on the dash or they may be subject to towing at the owner's expense. Thank you for your assistance in this matter.
15. Wagons must be parked in the hitching area north of the Heavy Horse barn when not in use. Cleanliness around the barns will be enforced. Penalties for failure to follow these rules will be enforced by deduction from prize money.

**NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS:**

Stock exhibitors: please use the extreme south entrance to the grounds to access the barns.

Stock exhibitors: please check program for judging schedule.

Barns will be cleaned at 7:00 A.M. All manure is to be taken to the manure bunkers at the south end of the barns.

Exhibitors must have control of their animals at all times when on the property of the Valley Agricultural Society.

All exhibitors should be neat and appropriately dressed before entering a show ring.

Exhibitors should at all time cooperate with the fair officials in parking of trucks and trailer; proper parking of wagons and buggies is requested, as is keeping their stalls in an orderly and tidy condition. No vehicles are allowed to park on the north side of the barns; they will be towed at the owner's expense.

Exhibitors are asked to refrain from the use of foul or abusive language in and around the stables and in the show ring.

**Hay and straw will NOT be available on site. Initial bedding will be provided.**

**Harness Pony Division**

12.2 and under, no cross entry to any other division except for Roadster Pony and pleasure driving Division. Ponies shown in Pleasure Driving Division may only be shown in section 121 and 122, no cross entry from classes 118, 119, 120, 123. To be shown at the gaits specified for each section both ways of the ring.

- 118 **Harness Pony – (Open)** to be shown at a Park Pace and Show your Pony.  
 119 **Harness Pony – (Amateur)** to be shown at a Park Pace, stand quietly and back easily.

 121 **Harness Pony – (Team)** to be shown at a Park Pace.  
 122 **Harness Pony – (Tandem)** to be shown at a Park Pace  
 123 **Harness Pony Stake – to be eligible, must have been entered and shown in any single class in this division** to be shown at a Park Pace and Show your Pony.

**Hackney Pony Roadster Division**

12.2 and under shown to a 2-wheeled jog cart, and stable colours to be worn. To enter the ring to the left and to be shown at a jog trot and road gait the first way of the ring, and to reverse at the jog trot. Once reversed shall jog trot, road gait and then drive with speed (Drive on). Ponies may cross enter to the Harness Pony Division and the Pleasure Division but not BOTH except for sections 121 and 122 and Junior Exhibition Division.
