ENTRY DAY:

Tuesday, July 3 from 6:00 P.M. – 9:00 P.M. **AND** Wednesday, July 4, 2012 from 6:00 – 9:00 p.m. at the **SOUTH ORANGE BUILDING** located on the Valley Agricultural Society Property.

****All entries must be picked up by Sunday, July 22, 2012 - Exhibits not claimed by Monday, July 23, 2012, at 3:00 p.m. will be destroyed.**

PRIZES:

1st - \$3.00 2nd - \$2.00 3rd - \$1.00

All prizes in School Exhibits will be paid in cash at the Stampede Office (to the west of the grand stand). All prize winners must sign for their money. Prize money not claimed by September 4th 2012 will be forfeited.

****Money will be available at the Fair Office for pick up after July 16, 2012****

RULES:

1. No more than one entry is allowed per exhibitor per class. You may enter in classes in grades above, but not below.
2. Entries must have been completed within the last year by the exhibitor and may have been made at school, home or clubs.
3. We value your artwork, and will strive to maintain its condition, however, the Committee is not responsible for any damages that may occur.
- 4. IF YOUR NAME IS VISIBLE ON THE EXHIBIT, IT MUST BE CROSSED OUT OR TAPED OVER. OR THE ENTRY WILL BE CONSIDERED VOID.**
5. No Brand Names of Products may be used on any articles.
6. All entry tags are to be filled in by the Exhibitor and stapled to the lower right hand corner of the exhibit. Your exhibitor number will be given to you on entry day.
7. Neatness, originality and general appearance will be considered in placing awards.

DEFINITIONS:

PICTURE MAKING – Picture making means telling a story through pictures. Use lead or colored pencil only. If it states Crayon only, please do not draw it with pencil, use only the Crayon.

CREATIVE DESIGN – Use only the media designated; CD paper means a mask or paper chain – anything totally paper. CD cut is perhaps a shaped picture, mosaics or weaving – all parts being cut.

SEASONAL ARTICLES – Example: Halloween picture, Christmas craft, Easter arrangement, etc.

COMPUTER GRAPHIC DESIGN - This can be a design done on a 'Paint' or design Program on a computer and printed off. Please mount these on poster paper. There will be prizes for grades 2 through 6.

PHOTO SCRAPBOOK PAGE - This is one page from a decorative photo scrapbook. Please have a theme (i.e. child's birthday, summer vacation, sports.)

SCHOOL WORK AGGREGATE TROPHY:

The girl and boy accumulating the most prize money in School Work will receive a trophy sponsored by **Rempel Insurance Brokers**. Open to any student, preschool to Grade 6. The trophy will be presented on Sunday, July 22, 2012 during the evening show at the Rempel Insurance Stage.

PENMANSHIP SPECIAL:

The penmanship special is sponsored by **Red River Valley School Division** and open to all children from Kindergarten to Grade 6.

Prizes amounts are as follows: 1st place - \$6.00 2nd place - \$4.00 3rd place - \$2.00

The penmanship guidelines are:

1. Each entry to be made on one side of loose leaf or foolscap and mounted.
2. Kindergarten to Grade 3 must be in pencil. Grade 4-6 must be in blue or black ink.
3. Kindergarten to Grade 2 must be printed. Grade 3-6 must be in handwriting.
4. Grade level must be in top right corner with entry tag stapled to lower right hand corner.
5. Entry must include:
 - a) Alphabet in lower and upper case letters
 - b) Numbers 0-9
 - c) Remainder of page to be filled with prose or poetry
(Except Kindergarten)
6. Entries judged on neatness and form only. Samples are given in the back of the booklet.
